New Outreach Activity

A workshop on Seismic Safety Agenda in North-Eastern Region of India was conducted at IIT Guwahati on March 22, 2014. The workshop was attended by 29 participants representing JEC Jorhat, NIT Meghalaya, AEC Guwahati, AEI Guwahati, IIST Shibpur, NHPC Guwahati, ASDMA Guwahati, GMDA Guwahati, Professional Engineers and Architects in addition to IIT Guwahati and IIT Kanpur. Several issues related to seismic risk in North-Eastern region of India were discussed in the day long workshop. Though the awareness about the seismic hazard is high in the region, innovative strategies are required to reduce the growing seismic risk due to existing vulnerable structures and further increase in their inventory. The agenda for addressing the seismic risk mitigation issues in the region was drawn up. This workshop was partially supported by Poonam & Prabhu Goel Foundation at IIT Kanpur.

Necessity was long felt to address the issues of Seismic Safety in the North-Eastern Region of India, which is primarily in zone V. The recent meeting at IIT Guwahati provided us the opportunity to get a first-hand input on the problems specific to the region. Action agenda for the same is now being designed. 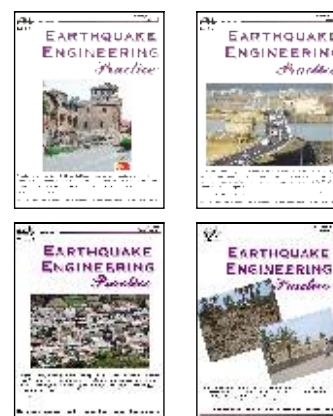
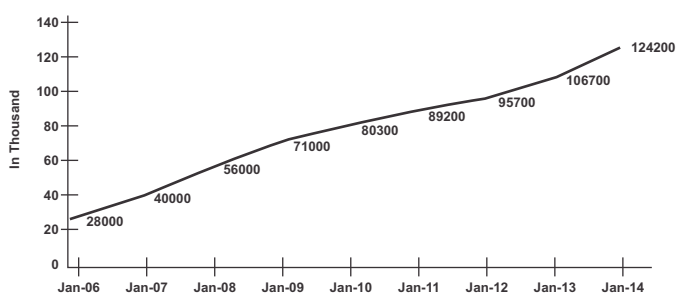

Aggressive Dissemination of Literature

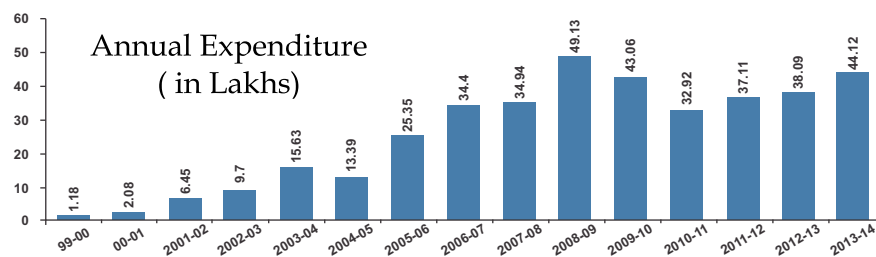
During the year 17,500 copies of books, monographs, and CDs, were distributed. Till date, NICEE has distributed 1,24,200 such items.



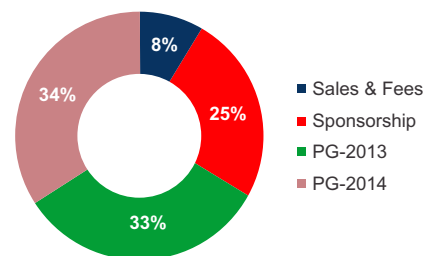
Earthquake Engineering Practice

Funding of Expenses – 2013-14



With a healthy growth of NICEE activities, the overall expenditure during the year stood at about ₹ 44.12 lakhs (₹ 38.09 lakhs last year). This was covered by a healthy mix of resources from various sources: 8% from sales and fees, 25% from sponsorships, 33% and 34% from Prabhu Goel Foundation for financial years 2012-13 and 2013-14, respectively. IIT Kanpur provided a support of ₹ 9.00 lakhs towards upgradation of office equipments.

The sale proceeds from publications and monographs were ₹ 12.07 lakhs as compared to ₹ 12.03 lakhs last year. The number of donors this year were 77 (64 last year) contributing a total of ₹ 4.30 lakhs with an average donation of ₹ 5,582/- (₹ 8.81 lakh last year with average of ₹ 13,765/-). Since inception, NICEE has received one or more donations from a total of 494 donors with an overall median of ₹ 3,000: this is a great endorsement of NICEE's activities by its friends and well wishers.
